APPLICATION PERIOD: Dec. 1, 2008-Feb. 10, 2009

AMOUNT: \$5,000 a year up to \$20,000

CRITERIA: Minimum 2.75 GPA. US Citizen or permanent resident. Pursuing a Bachelor's degree. Enrolling in a public college or university Fall 2009. Demonstrate financial need (must fill out FAFSA). Possesses entrepreneurial spirit.
