NAME: Gates Millennium Scholars

DEADLINE: January 12, 2009

AMOUNT: \$5,000 a year up to \$20,000

CRITERIA: Cumulative GPA of 3.3. Demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular or other activities. Meet Federal Pell Grant Eligibility criteria (Fill out FAFSA). Must be African American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American.
