University of California (UC)

- Must complete the A-G subject requirements.
- UC admission Test Requirement: **ACT** (plus the Writing Test), or **SAT Reasoning** (critical reading, mathematics and writing).
 - In addition, all applicants must complete **two SAT Subject Tests** in **two different subject areas**: history/social science, English literature, mathematics (level 1 or level 2), laboratory science or language other than English.

Application period is November 1-30. Apply online: www.ucop.edu/pathways

California State University (CSU)

- Must complete the A-G subject requirements.
- CSU Test Requirement: ACT (Writing Test not required) or SAT Reasoning.

Application period is Oct 1-Nov. 30. Apply online: www.csumentor.edu
